All reports must have your first and last name, your grade level, and date.

Reports must include the title of the book, author, characters, setting, and plot in some form, whether it be written or represented.

1. Traditional Book Report (See attached form)
2. Submarine Sandwich Report (Build a sandwich using “slices” of the story)
3. Lunch Bag (Fill a lunch bag with items that re-tell the story, or tell about the characters)
4. Be a Book Critic (Write a newspaper review of the book)
5. Bring a Character to Life (Dress up as a character from the book and share the story with the class)
6. Make a Book Jacket
7. Interview a Character
8. Make a Brochure
9. Book Mobile
10. Make Diary Entries
11. Make a puppet and write a scene depicting main ideas
12. Make a Movie Poster
13. Draw a Comic Strip
14. Make a collage representing the story
15. Make a Playbill
16. Use a shoebox to make a model of a scene or the main idea
17. Write a speech for one of the characters
18. Create a timeline and illustrate
19. Write a song including scenes and events in sequence
20. Create a CD or Album Cover (songs could be events from the story, characters could be singers, band members, etc.)
21. Develop a Headline News Article
22. Create a PowerPoint
23. Create a Video Clip about the book

24. Write a New Conclusion
25. Create a Scrapbook
26. Make a model or sculpture
27. Paint, Draw, Create a triptych (3 pictures) that shows characters, events, and setting.
